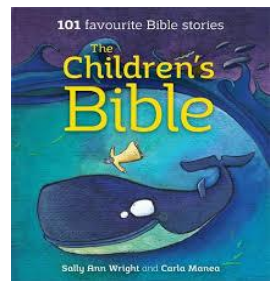
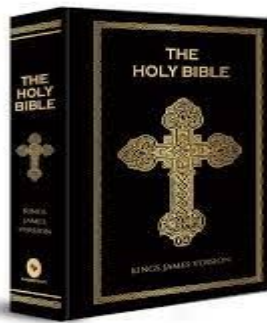

## Why are Bible Stories Important to Christians?

**Substantive Knowledge - Bible stories teach Christians how to live their lives**

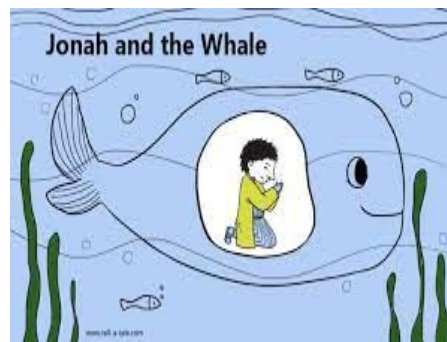
### The Bible is the Holy Book For Christians

The Bible has laws, stories, prayers and songs which Christians learn from to help them live better lives.



### Jonah and the Whale

During his sea journey, a great storm appears, and Jonah is thrown overboard and swallowed by a huge fish (or whale). Jonah prays to God and is rescued after 3 days. The message to Christians is to have faith in God (believe He will help).



### The Feeding of The Five Thousand

Jesus is able to feed 5000 people with only 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish. They do not run out. The message to Christians is to have faith in God and Jesus (believe He will help). The story also shows that Christians should look after others.



### Christians believe that Jesus is the Son of God

Many Christians believe that Jesus was God coming to Earth. The bible has stories about His life.

Christians celebrate Jesus' birth at Christmas.
