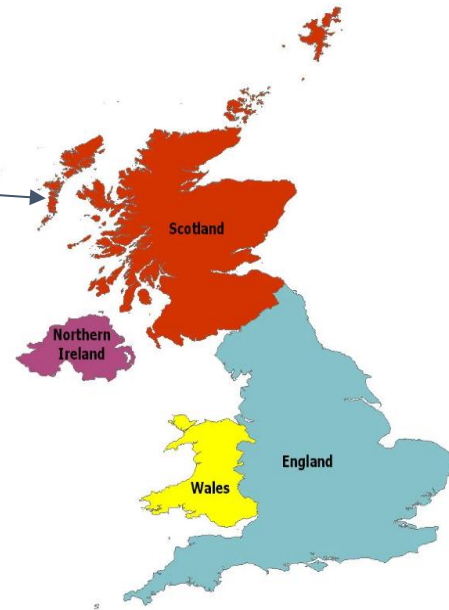

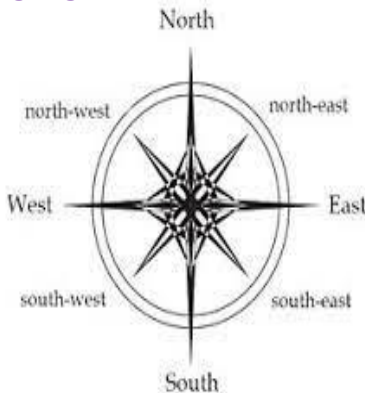
What can we find out about Flemington, Australia?

Substantive Knowledge

To know where the U.K is on a world map; to label a blank map with the seven continents and five oceans of the world.



To identify the four countries of the U.K. and use simple compass directions and locational language to locate them.



Scotland is to the north of the U.K..

England is to the south of the U.K. and is the largest country in the U.K..

Wales is to the west of England. All three of these countries share landmass.

Separated by the Irish sea, Northern Ireland is the most western country in the United Kingdom.

Other vegetables originated in Australia, including warrigal greens

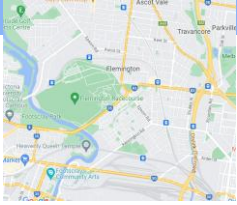

- It is a suburb of the city of Melbourne



- Flemington Racecourse is famous for the Melbourne Cup horse race which takes place every year in November.



- There are twelve parks and open spaces in Flemington.
- There are a mix of house styles including semi-detached and detached family homes, terraced houses dating back to the Victorian and Edwardian eras.
- People can get about using the main road that runs through the centre of the town as well as buses, trams and train via two train stations.
