What is the significance of The Holy Trinity?

Substantive Knowledge – Christians believe that the Holy Trinity (The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit) show God's omnipotence. Jesus' resurrection is evidence of heaven.

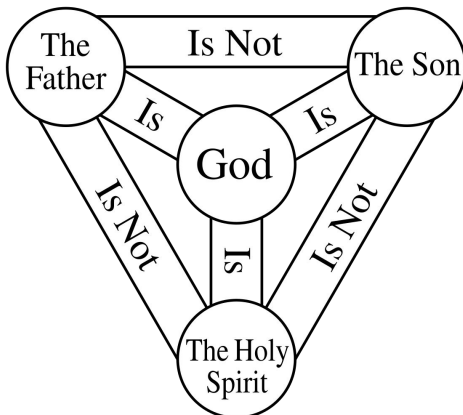
What do Christians believe about Jesus Christ – the human and divine?



Jesus was the Messiah (Christ), the Son of God who was crucified for the sins of humans before rising from the dead, according to Christian Gospels and early Christian scripture.

Trinity, in Christian doctrine, the unity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit as three persons in one Godhead. The doctrine of the Trinity is considered to be one of the central Christian affirmations about God.

The Holy Trinity



Most Christians believe there is only one God, who is experienced as three persons, also known as the Trinity. These three persons are the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. They believe that Jesus was God on Earth in human form and known as the Son of God.

Christians believe that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit teaches them about relationships.



Christmas and Easter

Christians believe the celebrations Christmas and Easter are evidence of Jesus' birth and death and resurrection. They believe Jesus Christ was resurrected showing the presence of the afterlife and heaven.

To know that Christians believe Jesus' life and death helps them to have a relationship with God.

Jesus' temptations



At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights and afterwards was hungry. The tempter approached and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become loaves of bread.

Stories of Jesus' Life

There are many stories about Jesus' life. These help Christians to follow His example and lead a Christian life.

The Lost Son - one son asks for his inheritance early and goes off to spend it. After he spends it all, he has to live rough until his father welcomes him back, forgiving him. This story teaches Christians about kindness and forgiveness.

The Good Samaritan - a man is beaten and stripped. A Jewish priest and a Levite ignore him but a kind man goes to his aid.

Teaches us to be kind to each other.
